Safety:

Personal safety is paramount. Both the header trailer and the headers loaded of them are heavy. When the combine operator is loading or unloading a header all persons **must stand clear** of the operation. Do not get in between or under any part of the of the two pieces of equipment.

The location of brackets or the support bar may require adjustment. If adjustment if necessary have the combine operator move the header back, away form the trailer and lower it to the ground. Make the adjustments and bring the header back over the trailer. The support bar is heavy and requires pinning in several places. Have enough people involved to do these adjustments safely. **Think safety!**

Loading:

1. When loading the header be certain that it is resting **against** <u>all</u> of the back stops (cradles or saddles). See **Fig. 1**. This is very important – it prevents load shifting and the possibility of having the header fall from the trailer. Note that the back stops are adjustable vertically and horizontally.

2. The support bar is also adjustable in two directions; up and down – in and out. **Figure 2** shows the adjustment. The vertical adjustment has four holes or positions. The "in – out" has seven holes. The support bar must be located out beyond the mid-point to provide the support needed. All pins must be in place and keyed. Different headers may require different settings.

3. **Fig. 3** shows the points were the header rests on the support bar.

Securing:

Once the header is safely loaded and properly supported it needs to be strapped down. The trailer has six pairs of hold down brackets. See two of them in **Fig. 4.** Use the the pairs that best




Figure 5 Steps to securing header

fit your particular header, not all need be used. **Fig. 5** shows a strap hooked in a hold down bracket,

arrow numbered 1. The extra wrap around the tube positions the strap to come directly over the row unit at 2. The numbered arrow 3 is were the strap goes under the rubber flap of the back screen.

Fig. 6 shows the back side of the same strap.

Hooking to Tow Vehicle




Figure 7 Hooking-up

The Sheyenne header trailer can be towed by pick-up trucks, trucks, combines or tractors. Fig.7 shows a typical hook-up. Arrow number 1

points to the telescoping hitch feature. This is particularly useful when only one person is hooking-up.

Arrow 2 is the hitch pin and key. Select an appropriate diameter and length pin for the hitch.

Arrow 3 points to the safety chains. The trailer is equipped with these chains. If these should ever need replacement, do so with an equal quality chain. <u>Always</u> connect these to the towing vehicle!

Arrow 4 points to the electrical connector. <u>Always</u> plug in this connector! It controls all signal lights, clearance lights, brake lights and the electrical brakes. **Plug in the connector!**

Lubrication:




Figure 9 Grease Zerks on Steering

The header trailer has only two grease fittings, seen in **Fig. 9**. All wheel bearings are sealed.


Figure 13 Electric Brakes

The forward axle of the trailer has electric brakes. Fig. 13.
